

DECREE LAW NO. 83 of 5 June 2015

We the Captains Regent of the Most Serene Republic of San Marino

*Having regard to Decree no.83 of 10 April 2015 – urgent provisions to combat terrorism, promulgate:
Having regard to the conditions of necessity and urgency referred to in Article 2,
paragraph 2, letter b) of Constitutional Law no. 183 of 15 December 2005 and Article 12
of Qualified Law no. 184 of 15 December 2005 and namely:*

- *the need to adapt the existing legislation on international cooperation and judicial assistance in order to strengthen security and develop cooperation between the states in the fight against terrorism and to introduce new offenses;*
- *the urgent need to give immediate feedback to the aforementioned need for rapid adaptation to the latest international standards;*

Having regard to Congress of State Decision no. 1, adopted during its sitting of 10 April 2015;

Having regard to amendment of the Decree above in connection with ratification of the same from the Great and General Council adopted during its sitting of 27 May 2015;

Having regard to Great and General Council Decision no.27 of 27 May 2015;

Having regard to Articles 8 and 9, paragraph 5, of Qualified Law no. 186/2005;

Promulgate and order the publication of the Decree-Law no. 47 of 10 April 2015 as amended as a result of the amendment approved by the Great and General Council at the time of ratification of the same:

URGENT PROVISIONS TO COMBAT TERRORISM

Article 1

After the article 13 of Decree-Law of 15 July 2013 no. 83, the following is inserted:

“CHAPTER III bis

SUPPRESSION OF TERRORIST ACTS USING EXPLOSIVE DEVICES

Article 13bis

(Terrorist attacks using explosive devices)

1. Whoever, for the purpose of causing death or serious bodily injury or with the intent to cause extensive destruction to places, buildings or facilities, delivers, places, operates or detonates explosives or other lethal device in, into a place of public use, in a building for public use, against goods, infrastructure or resources for public use or on a public transportation system or related service facilities shall be punished with imprisonment of seventh grade.
2 Applies imprisonment of eighth grade and fourth-degree disqualification if the facts stated in the preceding paragraph comes the death of one or more persons. ”.

Article 2

Article 1 letter p) of the Law n. 92 of 17 June 2008, after the words “international organization”, the following is inserted: "Moreover, represents "terrorism" or "terrorist act", any other conduct

foreseen and defined in the international Convention for the Suppression of Terrorism financing and its annexes; "
